

#### **LICENSING ACT 2003**

Hearing to consider a notice of objection to 2 no Temporary Event Notices.

#### Prospect Farm Kirk Edge Road Sheffield S6 6LJ

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider a notice of objection submitted by Sheffield City Council Environmental Protection Service relating to two temporary event notices for the premises known as Prospect Farm Kirk Edge Road Sheffield.

#### 2.0 THE TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE

- 2.1 The proposed premises user is Martin Hague.
- 2.2 The temporary event notices, which were received on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2014 are attached to this report labelled Appendix 'A'.
- 2.3 The events are as follows:

Event 1 – Wedding 12.00 12<sup>th</sup> July 2014 to 23.30 12<sup>th</sup> July 2014 (Tipi in field)

Event 2 - Wedding 12.00 19th July 2014 to 23.30 19th July 2014 (Tipi in field)

- 2.4 The licensable activities intended to be carried on at the premises are:
  - The sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on the premises
  - The provision of regulated entertainment

#### 3.0 REASONS FOR REFERRAL

- 3.1 A notice was submitted by Sheffield City Council on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2014, objecting to the temporary event notices. The notices of objection are attached at Appendix 'B'.
- 3.2 The applicant and the objecting officer from 3.1 have been invited to attend the hearing. Copies of the front page of the notices are attached to this report labelled Appendix 'C'.

#### 4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 There are no specific financial implications arising from this application. However, additional costs may be incurred should the matter go to appeal. In such an eventuality it may not be possible to recover all these costs. The impact of these additional costs (if any) will be kept under review and may be subject of a further report during the year.

#### 5.0 THE LEGAL POSITION

- 5.1 A Chief Police Officer or Environmental Protection Service of the Local Authority may object to a Temporary Event Notice.
- 5.2 Where such an objection is received, the relevant licensing authority must -
  - (a) hold a hearing to consider the objection notice, unless the premises user, the Chief Police Officer / Environmental Protection Service who gave the objection notice and the authority agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and
  - (b) having regard to the objection notice, give the premises user a counter notice under this section if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the relevant licensing objective to do so."

#### 6.0 HEARINGS REGULATIONS

- 6.1 Regulations governing hearings under the Licensing Act 2003 have been made by the Secretary of State.
- 6.2 The Licensing Authority has provided all parties with the information required in the Regulations to the 2003 Act as set out at Appendix 'C'.
- 6.3 Attached at Appendix 'C' is the following: -
  - a) a copy of the Notice of Hearing;
  - b) the rights of a party provided in Regulations 15 and 16;
  - c) the consequences if a party does not attend or is not represented at the hearing
  - d) the procedure to be followed at the hearing.

#### 7.0 APPEALS

7.1 The Licensing Act 2003 section 181 and Schedule 5 makes provision for appeals to be made by the premises user and the chief officer of Police against decisions of the Licensing Authority, to the Magistrates' Court.

#### 8.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

8.1 That members carefully consider the representations made and take such steps, as the Committee consider necessary for the promotion of the crime prevention objective.

#### 9.0 OPTIONS OPEN TO THE COMMITTEE

- 9.1 To acknowledge the temporary event notice, allowing the event to go ahead on the proposed date as per the application
- 9.2 To acknowledge the temporary event notice, allowing the event to go ahead on the proposed date with conditions
- 9.3 To give the premises user a counter notice if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

Dear Mr Martin Hague,

Please note my objection to the two TENs applied for at Prospect Farm on 12th & 19th July 2014.

The application includes Regulated Entertainment, including a live band, and is to be held in a marquee/tepee. Such structures offer negligible sound attenuation. This application seeks to site tepees with regulated entertainment at Prospect Farm, Kirk Edge Road. I am unclear on the proposed location of the tepee in the field, as not site plan is included with the TEN. However, A review of our mapping system shows that Prospect Farm is less than 50m from its nearest residential neighbouring property, Parkside. According to my map search today, a number of other residential and noise sensitive properties are also within about 0.6km of the property, including Kirk Edge Carmelite Monastery (a silent retreat at about 350m distance). Experience has demonstrated that amplified music from such events can be heard across the High & Low Bradfield valley and, unless suitably controlled, may cause nuisance at residential locations considerable distances away.

I am making this objection now as the applications have only come to my attention on the third (and last) day for representations to be made. I hope that we can discuss the matter further next week, to establish if suitable controls may be available. If this is the case, I will withdraw my objection. However, if such controls cannot be agreed, or it appears that public nuisance remains a likely outcome, I shall have to make formal representation to any Licensing sub-committee scheduled to hear this objection.

15. Subject to regulations 14(2) and 25, a party may attend the hearing and may be assisted or represented by any person whether or not that person is legally qualified.

  - (d) Members may ask questions of those parties
  - (e) With the leave of the Chair the applicant or his representative may cross examine the representatives of the Responsible Authorities and Interested Parties
  - (f) The applicant/licensee (or his/her nominated representative) will then be asked to:-
    - (i) detail the application;
    - (ii) provide clarification on the application and respond to the representations made.
  - (g) The applicant/licensee (or his/her nominated representative) may then be asked questions by members and with the leave of the Chair from the other parties present.
  - (h) The applicant will then be given the opportunity to sum up the application.
  - (i) The Licensing Officer will then detail the options.
  - (j) There will then be a private session for members to take legal advice and consider the application.
- 6. The decision of the Licensing Committee will be given in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and regulations made there under.
- NB: 1) At any time in the Licensing Process Members of the Committee may request legal advice from the Solicitor to the Committee. This advice may be given in open session or in private.
  - 2) The Committee Hearing will be held in public unless and in accordance with the Regulations the Committee determine that the public should be excluded.
