58/19	Application for an extension of a Private Hire Vehicle Licence	Grant a licence for 11 months on the grounds that the applicant has provided sufficient evidence to convince the Sub-Committee that there are exceptional reasons to deviate from the current policy on the age limit of vehicles.
59/19	Application for an extension of a Private Hire Vehicle Licence	Grant a licence for 10 months on the grounds that the applicant has provided sufficient evidence to convince the Sub-Committee that there are exceptional reasons to deviate from the current policy on the age limit of vehicles.
60/19	Application for a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence	Agree to offer the applicant a further opportunity to attend a meeting.
61/19	Application for a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence	Grant a licence for two years, as requested, on the grounds that the Sub-Committee considers the applicant to be a fit and proper person to hold a licence.
