103/13	Review of a Hackney	In the light of the information contained in

	Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence	the report and the responses to questions provided by the licence holder, (a) suspend the licence under Section 61 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 until the licence holder successfully completes the Council's driving assessment test; and (b) officers be authorised to immediately suspend the licence if any further problems are reported, and then refer the licence back to the Sub-Committee for review.
