

# THE GROUNDS FOR REGISTRATION OF A TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN

- (1) Any person may apply to the commons registration authority to register land to which the Part ie part 1 of the Commons Act 2006, registration applies as a town or village green in a case where subsection (2), (3) or (4) applies.
- (2) This subsection applies where
  - (a) a significant number of the inhabitants of any locality, or of any neighbourhood within a locality, have indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land for a period of at least 20 years; and
  - (b) they continue to do so at the time of application.
- (3) This subsection applies where
  - (a) a significant number of the inhabitants of any locality, or of any neighbourhood within a locality, indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land for a period of at least 20 years;
  - (b) they ceased to do so before the time of the application but after the commencement of this section; and
  - (c) the application is made within the period of two years beginning with the cessation referred to in paragraph (b).

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My partner's mother, Jean Hoing, was born in 1931 and lived on nearby Woodview Road moving to Lister Road in 1959. Her mother, Amy Franks, was born in 1878 and grew up on Walkley Bank Road. During all this time the 'green' was common land and the dirt path which ran across it was a right of way used by everyone. Jean's father-in-law by her first marriage, Ernest Lockwood, lived on Walkley Bank and Jean remembers that at one time kept chickens in a pen on the green as it was common land. Likewise others tried to grow fruit and vegetables but the land was not rich enough so they gave up.

  - (a) a significant number of the inhabitants of any locality, or of any neighbourhood within a locality, indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land for a period of at least 20 years;
  - (b) they ceased to do so before the time of the application but after the commencement of this section; and
  - (c) the application is made within the period of two years beginning with the cessation referred to in paragraph (b).
- (4) This subsection applies (subject to subsection (5), where -
  - (a) a significant number of the inhabitants of any locality, or of any neighbourhood within a locality, indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land for a period of at least 20 years;
  - (b) they ceased to do so before the commencement of this section; and
  - (c) the application is made within the period of five years beginning with the cessation referred to in paragraph (b).



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
