1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Joint Committee was initially established in 2015 to consider health service reconfiguration over the “Commissioners Working Together” footprint (Barnsley, Derbyshire, Doncaster, Nottinghamshire, Rotherham, Sheffield, Wakefield) – looking at changes to children’s surgery and anaesthesia, and hyper acute stroke services.
