Subject: Urgent Care Update

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Summary:

As per the Local Authority (Public Health, Health and Wellbeing Boards and Health Scrutiny) Regulations 2013, the Healthier Communities and Adult Social Care Scrutiny Committee responded formally to NHS Sheffield Clinical Commissioning Group's proposals to change Urgent Primary Care Services in Sheffield. The Committee's response is attached as appendix A.

The CCG has informed us that given the strength of feeling and some of the issues raised during the consultation, that they feel they need to look again at the proposals. The decision will be made by the Primary Care Commissioning Committee on the 20th September, and the paper is attached as appendix B. The paper recommends that the Primary Care Commissioning Committee reconsiders urgent care proposals for minor illness and minor injuries, agrees not to progress the proposed changes to urgent eye care, and receives a revised pre-consultation business case in summer 2019.
