Sheffield Youth Cabinet: "The Sheffield Youth Cabinet aim to represent the voice of all young people aged 11-18 who live in Sheffield. As a part of their role they work on campaigns to make adults and other young people look at and listen to the issues that you want seen and heard. This work is voluntary and they are all passionate about making Sheffield and the UK a better and fairer place for young people."
