<u>Questions of Councillor Douglas Johnson to Councillor Terry Fox (Cabinet Member for Finance, Resources and Governance)</u>

- Q.1 What conference venues has the Council booked in external premises in the last 12 months?
- A.1 The Council has booked three venues, for four conferences, at external premises in the last twelve months.
 - External premises were used as there was nothing suitable internally at the time
- Q.2 What is the total expenditure for these conferences for each venue?
- A.2 The conference events and associated costs are detailed below:
 - 01.02.2019 Community Engagement Conference for the Community Safety Partnership (CSP): 60 attendees, at the Circle, at a total cost £287.70 made up of £90 equipment costs, rest for room hire
 - 18.07.19 Place Leadership Development Conference: 150 attendees, at the Showrooms, at a total cost £556.50 made up of £480 catering, and rest was room hire after discount of 27% was successfully negotiated after the event
 - 30.09.19 Place Middle Managers Conference: 100 attendees, at the Circle, at a cost of £266.70 made up of £70 catering and rest for room hire
 - 15.10.19 Opportunity Sheffield Employability Conference: 80 attendees, at St Mary's, at a cost of £1087 made up of £420 for room hire and £667 for catering.
