We acknowledge some young people in our communities are vulnerable to risk from the different relationships that young people form in their neighbourhoods, schools and online which can feature violence and abuse.

The Contextual Safeguarding Strategy will enhance the City's approach to safeguarding and it describes how we will identify contextual safeguarding risk, how we will ensure we deliver services to reduce risk and how we will know we've made a difference. This will ensure children and young people are in a safe environment, know how to keep safe and have help to thrive and grow to achieve their full potential.

We have defined a cohort of vulnerable young people and agreed a set of outcomes for them and their families. In delivering this strategy we will know these vulnerable young people have:

- Engaged with our interventions
- An improved Safety Scale / SDQ score as a result of our intervention
- A reduction in the percentage of education sessions missed.
- Not been missing from education (rolling total)
- A reduction in persistent absence
- Achieved 5+ A* -C grades at GCSE including English and mathematics
- Not entered Custody
- Not been involved in offending
- Not received a secure remand
- Not entered the criminal justice system
- Received an Out of Court Disposal as an intervention to prevent escalation of offending behaviour
- A reduced number of Missing episodes
- Not gone 'missing or run away' on two or more occasions
- A robust safety plan coordinated by a strategy meeting if they need one because they have gone 'missing or run away
- Provided feedback that is informing our service delivery and development

The Council considered it was not under a legal duty to consult with children and young people and their families (including parents/carers) or stakeholders on this strategy.

However as the strategy aims to re-affirm Sheffield's commitment to recognise and respond to child sexual exploitation, child criminal exploitation and the criminalisation of our young people, it was considered essential that multi-agency engagement informed the development of the strategy and targeted consultation should be undertaken to inform the equality impact assessment.

Significant engagement with elected members with responsibility for this area, all key partners, young advisors and service users has been undertaken during the development of the strategy.
