

Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), **I hereby give Notice** that:-

The **Cabinet** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of the Sheffield City Council on 17th June 2020.

The Key Decision will be about the **Future Delivery of Youth Services**.

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision, as required by Regulation 9 (2) of the Regulations.

The reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-

On 18th March 2020 officers submitted a Report to Cabinet proposing a new strategic approach to services to support the Young People of Sheffield with the aim that services for young people would be more inclusive, ambitious and collaborative. Given the proposed change in strategic approach it was also recommended in that report that a decision be taken not to re-procure the current youth services contract and that officers be tasked with submitting a further report to the Leader of the Council analysing the options for future delivery and recommending the most suitable delivery arrangements.

Cabinet approved the recommendations in the Report. However, that decision was subsequently called-in for scrutiny and the Scrutiny Committee on 21st May subsequently asked for further information about the proposals for the future delivery of services.

Due to significant disruption caused by the COVID-19 pandemic this Report (which was originally going to go to the Leader in April) was put on hold. However, following the Scrutiny decision, which asked for information that was due to be covered in this Report in any event, the decision has been taken to bring this Report forward at the earliest opportunity, namely the Cabinet meeting of 17th June.
