**Summary:**

To seek authority to process the Public Path Closure Order required to close the footpath (that has no formal status) between Knutton Rise and Public Footpath ECC\117 in the Parson Cross area of Sheffield, shown hatched black on the plan attached as Appendix A.

**Reasons for Recommendations**

Based on the information in the report the Council is satisfied that the proposed closure of the footpath is necessary to enable the Development to be carried out.

**Recommendations:**

Raise no objections to the proposed closure of the footpath off Knutton Rise, as shown hatched black on the plan included as Appendix A, subject to satisfactory arrangements being made with Statutory Undertakers in connection with any of their mains and services that may be affected.

Authority be given to the Director of Legal and Governance to

- a. take all necessary action to close the footpath by order under the powers contained within Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
  - b. confirm the order as an unopposed order, in the event of no objections being received, or any objections received being resolved and withdrawn prior to the order being confirmed.
