Annex 1A - Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory Condition 1 (Section 19 ss 2)

Where a licence authorises the sale of alcohol then no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Mandatory Condition 2 (Section 19 ss 3)

Where a licence authorises the sale of alcohol then every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory Condition 3 (Section 20)

- 1. Where a premises licence authorises the exhibition of films, the licence includes the following conditions relating to the admission of children to the exhibition:
 - (a) The admission of children (under 18) to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with the classification set by the film classification body (currently the BBFC).
 - (b) In a case where there is no classification given by the classification body (the BBFC) the admission of children to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation given by the Licensing Authority.
- 2. In this section -

"children" means persons aged under 18; and

"film classification body" means the person or persons designated as the authority under section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (c.39) (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification).

Mandatory Condition 4 (Section 21)

Where a premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Annex 1B - Mandatory Conditions effective from 6th April 2010:

These mandatory conditions apply where the licence authorises the supply of alcohol. The conditions in paragraph 1 to 3 do not apply where the licence authorises the sale by retail or supply of alcohol only for consumption off the premises.

 (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed encourage, individuals to- (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise); 	to require or alcohol the responsible		
(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other to promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at as defined in section 159 of the Act);	-

Annex 1C - Mandatory Conditions effective from 1st October 2010:

These mandatory conditions apply where the licence authorises the supply of alcohol. The condition 5 does not apply where the licence authorises the sale by retail or supply of alcohol only for consumption off the premises.

4. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

5. The responsible person shall ensure that-

- (a) Where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
 - (i) beer or cider: ¹/₂ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) Customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. Unsupervised children will not be allowed on the premises, all children must be accompanied by an adult.
- A permanent fixed residual device (RCD) must protect the electrical power serving all amplified music equipment used for the purposes of live music.
- 3. Customers will be reminded to leave the premises quietly and respect the neighbours.
- 4. A refusals book must be maintained and details of customers who cause a disturbance will be passed to Licence Watch and the Police when necessary.
- 5. Glasses must not be taken outside the premises.
- 6. Drinking water will be provided to customers.
- 7. Challenge 21 policy will be in place and anyone looking under 21 will be asked for proof of age.
- 8. Alcohol will only be sold ancillary to food in a seated environment.
- 9. All staff are to be trained regarding alcohol sales.

1. Capacity of the restaurant will be set at 50 persons.
