
### Initial Impact Overview

Based on the information about the proposal what will the overall equality impact?

We believe that the creation of the Living and Ageing Well Service will positively impact on the social care experiences of older adults and adults living with dementia in Sheffield.

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For the Living and Ageing Well Service, aligning community teams and homecare contracts with PCN areas provides the opportunity for closer alignment to health care providers and other partners. The intended outcome of this is to develop closer, collaborative working relationships with partners and so provide a higher quality of service to customers. Moving from generalised teams to specialisms will allow staff to develop a stronger skill base - rather than being 'jack of all trades.' This should result in a higher level of care being provided. However, this will only be achieved if adequate training and support is provided to staff. An improved workforce development offering is being planned, but further work is required to ensure support is in place as the programme moves into transition. This will be captured as part of the implementation planning and developed in collaboration with staff.
