#### LICENSING ACT 2003

Hearing to consider a notice of objection to a Temporary Event Notice.

### Unit 1a, Clarence Works, Effingham Road, Sheffield, S4 7YS

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To consider a notice of objection submitted by Sheffield City Council Health Protection Service relating to a temporary event notice for the premises known as Unit 1a, Clarence Works, Effingham Road, Sheffield, S4 7YS
- 2.0 THE TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE
- 2.1 The proposed premises user is Mr Daniel Metcalfe
- 2.2 The temporary event notice, which was received on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2013, is attached to this report labelled Appendix 'A'.
- 2.3 The event is as follows;
  - from 00:01 hours to 06:00 hours on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2013.
- 2.4 The nature of the event is described in the notice as a "Music based event with international DJs and musicians".
- 2.4 The licensable activities intended to be carried on at the premises are:
  - The sale by retail of alcohol
  - The provision of regulated entertainment

#### 3.0 REASONS FOR REFERRAL

- 3.1 A notice was submitted by Sheffield City Council Health Protection Service on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2013, objecting to the temporary event notice. The notice of objection is attached at Appendix 'B'.
- 3.2 The applicant and the objecting officer from 3.1 have been invited to attend the hearing. Copies of the front page of the notices are attached to this report labelled Appendix 'C'.

#### 4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 There are no specific financial implications arising from this application. However, additional costs may be incurred should the matter go to appeal. In such an eventuality it may not be possible to recover all these costs. The impact of these additional costs (if any) will be kept under review and may be subject of a further report during the year.

#### 5.0 THE LEGAL POSITION

5.1 Section 104 (2) of the Licensing Act states:

"Where a chief officer of police who receives a copy notice.... is satisfied that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine the crime prevention objective, he must give a notice stating the reasons why he is so satisfied (an "objection notice") –

- (a) to the relevant licensing authority, and
- (b) to the premises user."

#### 5.2 Section 105 (2) states:

"The relevant licensing authority must -

- (a) hold a hearing to consider the objection notice, unless the premises user, the chief officer of police who gave the objection notice and the authority agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and
- (b) having regard to the objection notice, give the premises user a counter notice under this section if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the crime prevention objective to do so."

#### 6.0 HEARINGS REGULATIONS

- 6.1 Regulations governing hearings under the Licensing Act 2003 have been made by the Secretary of State.
- 6.2 The Licensing Authority has provided all parties with the information required in the Regulations to the 2003 Act as set out at Appendix 'C'.
- 6.3 Attached at Appendix 'C' is the following:
  - a) a copy of the Notice of Hearing:
  - b) the rights of a party provided in Regulations 15 and 16:
  - c) the consequences if a party does not attend or is not represented at the hearing
  - d) the procedure to be followed at the hearing.

#### 7.0 APPEALS

7.1 The Licensing Act 2003 section 181 and Schedule 5 makes provision for appeals to be made by the premises user and the chief officer of Police against decisions of the Licensing Authority, to the Magistrates' Court.

#### 8.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

8.1 That members carefully consider the representations made and take such steps, as the Committee consider necessary for the promotion of the crime prevention objective.

#### 9.0 OPTIONS OPEN TO THE COMMITTEE

- 9.1 To acknowledge the temporary event notice, allowing the event to go ahead on the proposed date.
- 9.2 To give the premises user a counter notice if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.



#### Right of attendance, assistance and representation

15. Subject to regulations 14(2) and 25, a party may attend the hearing and may be assisted or represented by any person whether or not that person is legally qualified.

#### Representations and supporting information

16. At the hearing a party shall be entitled to -

- (a) in response to a point upon which the authority has given notice to a party that it will want clarification under regulation 7(1)(d), give further information in support of their application, representations or notice (as applicable),
- (b) if given permission by the authority, question any other party, and

(c) address the authority

#### Failure of parties to attend the hearing

20. – (1) If a party has informed the authority that he does not intend to attend or be represented at a hearing, the hearing may proceed in his absence.

(2) If a party who has not so indicated fails to attend or be represented at a hearing the

authority may:-

(a) where it considers it to be necessary in the public interest, adjourn the hearing to a specified date, or

(b) hold the hearing in the party's absence.

(3) Where the authority holds the hearing in the absence of a party, the authority shall consider at the hearing the application, representations or notice made by that party.

(4) Where the authority adjourns the hearing to a specified date it must forthwith notify the parties of the date, time and place to which the hearing has been adjourned.

### Procedure at hearing

- 21. Subject to the provisions of the Regulations, the authority shall determine the procedure to be followed at the hearing.
- 22. At the beginning of the hearing, the authority shall explain to the parties the procedure which it proposes to follow at the hearing and shall consider any request made by a party under regulation 8(2) for permission for another person to appear at the hearing, such permission shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 23. A hearing shall take the form of a discussion led by the authority and cross-examination shall not be permitted unless the authority considers that cross-examination is required for it to consider the representations, application or notice as the case may require.
- 24. The authority must allow the parties an equal maximum period of time in which to exercise their rights provided for at regulation 16.
- 25. The authority may require any person attending the hearing who in their opinion is behaving in a disruptive manner to leave the hearing and may –

(a) refuse to permit that person to return, or

(b) permit him to return only on such conditions as the authority may specify, but such a person may, before the end of the hearing, submit to the authority in writing any information which they would have been entitled to give orally had they not been required to leave.
